A. Presentation on “Flipped Classroom”

East Noble High School math teacher Mrs. Amy DeWitt introduced “Flipping the Classroom” to the Board of Trustees. This new approach to teaching allows students to view videos or podcasts of classroom lectures at home for homework. In the classroom students apply what was learned, teachers act as a facilitator by circulating the room and providing assistance where necessary. This approach creates a student centered personalized learning environment and allows students to learn at their own pace. Students from Mrs. DeWitt Algebra 1 and AP Pre-calculus classes shared learning experiences and answered questions about this new technology.
