Please read through the following Use and Care Guidelines with your child and then indicate your understanding.



Proper Use and Care of iPod/iPads at Home



- 1. I will always have clean hands when using my iPod/iPad.
- 2. I will always use two hands when carrying my iPod/iPad.
- 3. I will make sure I always know where my iPod/iPad is.
- 4. I will be extra careful when taking my iPod/iPad home. I will keep it in the bubble wrap folder when I am carrying it back and forth from school to home. I will keep it in my backpack when going to and from school. I will not get it out on the bus. I will hold my backpack on my lap if my iPod/iPad is in it.
- 5. I will make sure that I am the only one using my iPod/iPad. Brothers, sisters, parents, and others are not to use my iPod/iPad.
- 6. I will only use apps, programs, and web pages that my teacher has instructed me to use.
- 7. I will not have liquids or food around the iPod/iPad EVER!
- 8. I will be responsible and make smart learning choices while using my iPod/iPad.
- 9. My parents and I understand that we are responsible for any damages to or theft of the iPod/iPad that occur due to negligence when it is in my possession.

Parental Consent to Take Device Home:

I understand that the iPod/iPad and the case that ENSC has provided my child with are the property of East Noble School Corporation. I understand that we will report any damage, loss, or theft of the iPod/iPad to ENSC personnel immediately. In addition, I understand that I may be held responsible for reimbursement for any damage or theft that occurs through an act of negligence which may occur when the device is at home.
